



CURRENT CHALLENGES IN INFECTION CONTROL – 2008

Are you up to the challenge? Are your decisions based on the latest information and recommendations? This 3-hour seminar will bring you the latest isolation guidelines from the Centers for Disease Prevention and Control (CDC) and the Association for Professionals in Infection Control (APIC) and how these guidelines can be applied to enhance infection prevention and control programs in your long term care facility. Also included in the program are: Outbreak Investigation and Management, recently approved blood tests for TB screening, and clinical management issues in the transmission and precautions of emerging pathogens.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This course will be of interest to all nursing and health care personnel as well as certified medical assistants who must identify infections, set up a course of action to prevent nosocomial transmission, and instruct staff on the newest infection prevention and control guidelines. The program will also assist administrators, directors of nursing, and others responsible for effective management of isolation precaution practices in their facility.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of this seminar, participants will be able to:

- 1) Name at least 3 elements of an effective infection prevention and control program in a LTCF according to newly published guidelines by the Association for Professionals in Infection Control (APIC).
- 2) List 5 components of Standard Precautions according to the updated guidelines by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- 3) State a potential consequence of isolation on a resident in a long term care facility that must be balanced against the benefits of infection control.
- 4) State the role that ongoing surveillance and cluster mapping play in early recognition of an outbreak.
- 5) List 3 control measures that should be in place to prevent the outbreak from affecting more residents.
- 6) Describe the role that education plays in empowering employees to take appropriate steps to contain the outbreak.
- 7) Identify 3 IC team members to immediately notify internally and 2 external departments that must be told about the outbreak.
- 8) Name 2 of the strains of *Enterobacteriaceae* most commonly producing ESBLs (Extended-spectrum B-Lactamases).
- 9) List 2 foods that could be contaminated with *Escherichia coli* serotype 0157:H7 and name 2 possible symptoms of an infection created from ingesting this pathogen.
- 10) Identify a resident placement concern and roommate criteria now that multiple strains of *Clostridium difficile* and MRSA can be causing infections in LTC facilities.
- 11) Describe a new test for TB screening.
