Urgent Care Services

We make it easy for you to access one of our four Urgent Care Centers seven days a week, including holidays. In addition to weekday hours, each center offers evening and weekend hours. And, they're located within John Muir Health doctor's offices so you can count on high quality, compassionate care at whichever location you visit.

When to go where

The seriousness and nature of your illness or injury determines where you should seek care. At John Muir Health Urgent Care Centers, we offer primary care services — including pediatric care — for many urgent, non-life threatening medical symptoms.

If you are concerned that your condition may be an emergency please call your personal physician, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.

Visit an Urgent Care Center if you have mild to moderate symptoms such as:

- Joint and muscle pain
- Rash
- Abdominal pain (mild to moderate)
- Burning with urination
- Headache (mild to moderate)
- Minor cuts
- Ear pain
- Sore throat and sinus pain
- Cough and fever

Go directly to an emergency room if you have severe conditions such as:

- Difficulty in breathing
- Unconsciousness
- Severe bleeding
- Poisoning or suspected poisoning
- Chest pain or pressure
- Moderate to severe burns
- Convulsions or seizures
- Serious head, neck, or back injury
- Loss of limb or broken bone

Make an appointment with your primary care doctor for conditions such as:

- Chronic pain
- Chronic disease management
- Physicals
