Coordinates patient transfers to John Muir Health hospitals from hospitals throughout Northern California

How to transfer a patient

- 1. ED physician calls the John Muir Health Regional Transfer Center at (925) 947-4488
- 2. The Transfer Coordinator, a Registered Nurse, helps to identify the appropriate John Muir Health location and physician specialty
 - Facilitates physician-to-physician communication
 - Ensures medical information is transferred to the new location
- 3. If required, the Transfer Center may also help to arrange patient transportation
