Overview

Cancer specialists provide the full range of clinical care at UCSF – John Muir Health Cancer Center in Berkeley, part of the UCSF Helen Diller Family Comprehensive Cancer Center. This includes treatment for both newly diagnosed and metastatic cancer patients, as well as ongoing surveillance and survivorship care.

Breast surgeons offer evaluation and workup as well as the latest minimally invasive techniques for patients with breast cancer or benign conditions of the breast such as lumps, pain, abnormal mammograms and nipple discharge. We also treat thyroid and parathyroid disease and evaluate masses and abnormalities of the head, neck and breast, some of which are benign.

CONDITIONS TREATED

- Cancer (including breast, colon, gastrointestinal, gynecologic, head and neck, lung, pancreas, prostate, multiple myeloma, sarcoma, thyroid)
- Hematology cases (benign)

- Breast ultrasound
- Breast biopsy (including ultrasound-guided core biopsy and fine needle aspiration)
- Bone marrow biopsy
