



URM Clerkship Scholarship

At the John Muir Health Family Medicine Residency, our mission is to inspire learners to flourish as family friendly, compassionate healers who provide high quality, comprehensive and equitable care in any practice setting. We commit to advocate for care of the vulnerable and underserved, cultivate leadership skills to reduce health disparities and promote diversity and inclusiveness. As part of this commitment, we are proud to offer three (3) \$3,000 scholarships to support underrepresented minority (URM) medical students who are selected to complete a 4th year clerkship at John Muir Health.

The John Muir Health Family Medicine Residency Scholarship Application Committee will review applications from URM students and consider factors including their personal statement, career path, community service, and interest in health equity & inclusion.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed and selected on a rolling basis, starting on **April 15, 2022**.

Benefits:

- \$3,000 scholarship in support of URM students
- Residency interview with John Muir Health's Family Medicine Residency Program
- Four-week inpatient or outpatient clerkship experience
 - Rotations are offered August 2022 through January 2023
- Participation in resident conferences and activities
- Participation in health outreach & education with community partners
- Mentorship by residents, faculty and program leadership
- Dedicated URM faculty serving as mentors

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered for one of our three (3) URM Clerkship Scholarships:

- Applicant **must** be a fourth year medical student from an underrepresented group in medicine (racial, ethnic, LGBTQ+, disability, low socioeconomic status, first-generation college student)

- Submit completed Clerkship Application
- Submit completed URM Clerkship Scholarship Application
- Submit Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Applicant must be currently enrolled in a LCME or AOA accredited US or Canadian medical school
- Have successfully completed USMLE or COMLEX Step 1 with a passing score
- Have completed at a minimum three of the third-year core rotations in Internal Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Ob-Gyn and Psychiatry/Behavioral Medicine
- Provide three (3) letters of recommendation for Surgery, Medicine and Pediatrics from a teaching hospital, if applicant's medical school does not have a clinical teaching hospital for core rotations
- Provide proof of current immunizations
