Conditions treated:

- Asthma
- Atypical mycobacterium of the lung

- Chronic cough
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Emphysema
- Interstitial lung disease
- Lung cancer
- Lung masses
- Occupational lung disease
- Pulmonary hypertension
- Pulmonary tuberculosis
- Pulmonary vascular disease
- Sarcoidosis of the lungs
- Sleep disorders

When to refer patients:

Patients who experience any of the following symptoms should be referred to Pulmonology.

- Have difficulty breathing
- Have a persistent cough
- Regularly cough up blood or mucus
- Have trouble exercising due to breathing problems
- Smoke
- CPAP user
- Sleep apnea
- Snoring

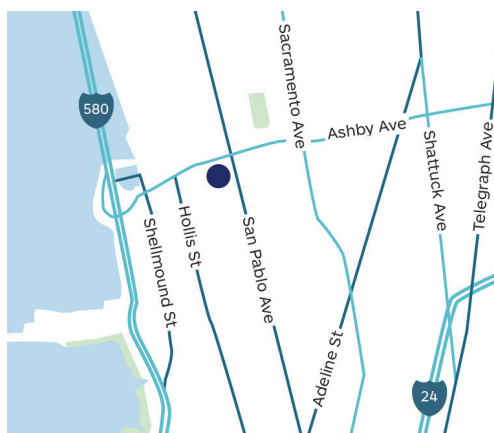
