When to refer patients:

Patients who experience any of the following symptoms should be referred to Vascular Surgery Services.

- Peripheral artery disease (PAD)
- Chronic limb ischemia
- Swelling and leg pain from lymphedema
- Deep vein thrombosis (DVT)
- Renal artery disease
- Pulmonary embolisms and blood clots
- Diabetic ulcers and venous leg wounds
