


## Download, Install & Configure VMware Horizon View Client for MAC


6. Click the **Downloads** located on the dock, next to trash bin. Choose VMware-Horizon-Client...dmg installer.



7. **Agree** to the license agreement.



8. Wait for the application installer to open.




9. Drag the VMware Horizon Client icon over to the **Applications** folder. Double click the **Applications** folder.




10. Locate and launch **VMware Horizon Client**.




11. Click **“Open”**




12. Select “Continue”




11. If presented with an “Unable to access Accessibility” dialog, click “OK”




12. “Open System Preferences”



13. Click the lock in the bottom left corner



14. Once unlocked click on “**Accessibility**”, select the “**Privacy**” tab, and check VMware Horizon Client. Click the lock again to complete the changes.



11. Enter “**VDI.JMHconnect.net**” and leave the “**Always connect at launch**” checked. Click “**Connect**”




13. When prompted, type in your JMH login credentials:

If accessing from an external (non JMH-facility) location, enter your **ID/User name** and **VIP Access 6-digit passcode** and click **Login**, followed by your **AD/Epic password** on the next screen.
